What is "Kaigoshokuin Shoninsha Kenshu"?

Kaigoshokuin Shoninsha Kenshuu provides the basic knowledge and skills required for caregiving and is considered an introductory certification for caregivers. To obtain this certification, individuals must complete approximately 130 hours of classes and pass an exam, which is conducted in Japanese. It is recommended to obtain this certification before starting work at caregiving facilities, as it may provide advantages in terms of wages and contract conditions.

What is this course's goal?

To equip participants with the necessary caregiving skills and knowledge to work in nursing care facilities in Kanagawa Prefecture.
